



## Visiting the Walt Disney World Resort Theme Parks and Resort Hotels

### POLICIES

- Prior to traveling:
  - We expect you to confirm that each traveler has a negative viral test taken no more than 1–3 days before travel. Test results **will not be collected by or provided to** Disney Youth Programs. You are required to prohibit any members of your group with confirmed positive test results from travelling to Walt Disney World Resort.
  - We expect that all members of your group, 14 days before travel, will reduce exposure to COVID-19. Unvaccinated travelers are expected to engage in a 2-week pre-arrival quarantine that includes physical distancing, wearing face coverings when not at home, avoiding unnecessary travel, and refraining from indoor social gatherings with people outside of their households.
  - In lieu of pre-arrival testing, you may choose to consider whether a traveler is or will be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. According to CDC guidance, persons should wait 2 weeks after completing vaccination for COVID-19 before traveling. Vaccination **is not required** and documentation of vaccination **will not be collected by or provided to** Disney Youth Programs.
- Stay home if you or other members of your party:
  - Are experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19 identified by the CDC: Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, fever or chills, muscle pain or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, new onset of nausea, diarrhea or vomiting
  - Have been in contact with someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 symptoms without completing a 14-day quarantine
  - Are under any self-quarantine orders

### FACE COVERINGS

- Proper face coverings are required for all Guests (ages 2 and up) while visiting the Walt Disney World Resort Theme Parks, Resort Hotels and Disney Springs®, including those who have received a COVID-19 vaccine
- Must be made with at least two layers of breathable material, fully cover the nose and mouth, be secure under the chin and be secured with ties or ear loops
- Please wear your own face covering at all times, except with dining or swimming.
- You may temporarily remove your face coverings while actively eating, drinking or taking an outdoor photo, but you must be stationary and maintain proper physical distancing during this time.

### GUEST PARTY SIZE

- Guest party size while traveling through the Walt Disney World Resort Theme Parks, Resort Hotels and Disney Springs® is limited to groups of five or less
- Guests must maintain physical distancing from those outside of your party

### HANDWASHING PROCEDURES

- The CDC recommends washing your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- If you cannot get to a hand washing station or a restroom, you can use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol

These are necessary measures to make sure that you and your group can enjoy your time at the Walt Disney World Resort. What's most important is that you did all that you could to help keep your fellow guests, friends and family healthy and safe. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.
